**T**HE best results are obtained in Filet Crochet by using as fine a needle as possible with the size thread. If too coarse a needle is used the work will be uneven and stretchy; with a fine needle the work will be crisp and even.

## MATERIALS

The worker may use any good thread and a suggestion of the size of needle to be used with different size threads is given below.

| No. of Cotton | No. of Needle | No. of Cotton | No. of Needle |
|---------------|---------------|---------------|---------------|
| 3             | 7             | 50            | 12            |
| 5             | 7             | 60            | 12            |
| 10            | 8             | 70            | 13            |
| 20            | 9             | 80            | 13            |

| 40            | 11            | 150           | 14            |

## ABBREVIATIONS and EXPLANATIONS

Chain (ch) is a series of loops each drawn through the preceding loop until the desired length is obtained.

Slip stitch (sl st); a stitch on the needle; put needle through work, draw thread through work and stitch at the same time.

Double crochet (d c); the stitch is made by one stitch on needle; thread over needle, put needle through work, and draw thread through two stitches, thread over again and draw through last two stitches.

Picot (p); a picot is made by a chain of 4 or more stitches according to size of picot and catching by sl st into first ch making a loop.

Single (s).

Group (gr).

When spaces (sp) are added at the beginning of row, make the necessary number of ch and add 5 more to turn and continue.

\*; indicates repetition.

# Pin Cushion Cover. No. 10

Worked with No. 60 Cordonnet Crochet Cotton

A very pretty d'oyley is made by placing the square medallion on linen and embroidering over the edge and fringing linen, leaving one-half inch or more of plain linen between medallion and fringe.

CHAIN 155, turn, 1 d in 8th st of chain.

1st row. 49 sp, ch 5; turn.

2d row. 18 sp, 40 d, 18 sp, ch 5; turn.

3d row. 17 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, 16 d, 4 sp, 4 d, 17 sp, ch 5; turn.

4th row. 16 sp, 4 d, 6 sp, 10 d, 6 sp, 4 d, 16 sp, ch 5; turn.

5th row. 4 sp, 4 d, 3 sp, 4 d, 6 sp, 4 d, 8 sp, 4 d, 8 sp, 4 d, 6 sp, 4 d, 3 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, ch 5; turn.

6th row. 5 sp, 10 d, 6 sp, 4 d, 6 sp, 7 d, 3 sp, 7 d, 6 sp, 4 d, 6 sp, 10 d, 5 sp, ch 5; turn.

7th row. 5 sp, 10 d, 5 sp, 4 d, 6 sp, 13 d, 1 sp, 13 d, 6 sp, 4 d, 5 sp, 10 d, 5 sp, ch 5; turn.

8th row. 5 sp, 10 d, 4 sp, 4 d, 6 sp, 16 d, 1 sp, 16 d, 6 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, 10 d, 5 sp, ch 5; turn.

9th row. 4 sp, 4 d, 3 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, 4 d, 5 sp, 16 d, 1 sp, 16 d, 5 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, 4 d, 3 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, ch 5; turn.

10th row. 14 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, 16 d, 1 sp, 16 d, 4 sp, 4 d, 14 sp, ch 5; turn.

11th row. 15 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, 13 d, 1 sp, 13 d, 4 sp, 4 d, 15 sp, ch 5; turn.

12th row. 16 sp, 4 d, 2 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, 4 d, 2 sp, 4 d, 16 sp, ch 5; turn.

13th row. 7 sp, 4 d, 8 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 19 d, 1 sp, 19 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 8 sp, 4 d, 7 sp, ch 5; turn.

14th row. 6 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 6 sp, 4 d, 2 sp, 16 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 16 d, 2 sp, 4 d, 6 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 6 sp, ch 5; turn.

15th row. 5 sp, 4 d, 3 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, 4 d, 3 sp, 16 d, 1 sp,

4 d, 1 sp, 16 d, 3 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, 4 d, 3 sp, 4 d, 5 sp, ch 5; turn.

16th row. 4 sp, 4 d, 5 sp, 4 d, 2 sp, 4 d, 5 sp, 7 d, 2 sp, 10 d, 2 sp, 7 d, 5 sp, 4 d, 2 sp, 4 d, 5 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, ch 5; turn.

17th row. 3 sp, 4 d, 7 sp, 7 d, 8 sp, 22 d, 8 sp, 7 d, 7 sp, 4 d, 3 sp, ch 5; turn.

18th row. 2 sp, 4 d, 18 sp, 22 d, 18 sp, 4 d, 2 sp, ch 5; turn.

19th row. 1 sp, 4 d, 10 sp, 10 d, 6 sp, 22 d, 6 sp, 10 d, 10 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, ch 5; turn.

20th row. 1 sp, 4 d, 5 sp, 10 d, 1 sp, 16 d, 6 sp, 16 d, 6 sp, 16 d, 1 sp, 10 d, 5 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, ch 5; turn.

21st row. 1 sp, 4 d, 4 sp, 16 d, 1 sp, 13 d, 5 sp, 4 d, 2 sp, 4 d, 2 sp, 4 d, 5 sp, 13 d, 1 sp, 16 d, 4 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, ch 5; turn.

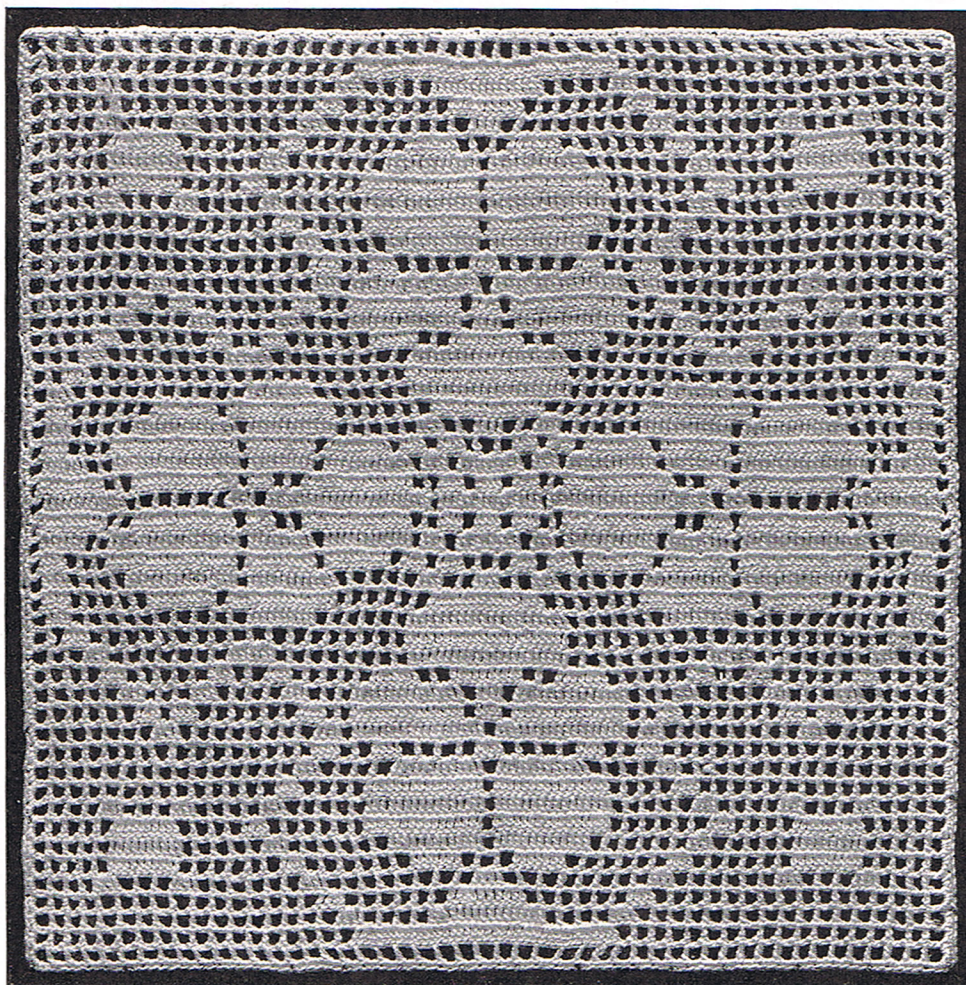
22d row. 1 sp, 4 d, 3 sp, 19 d, 1 sp, 10 d, 1 sp, 10 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 3 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 10 d, 1 sp, 10 d, 1 sp, 19 d, 3 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, ch 5; turn.

23d row. 1 sp, 7 d, 2 sp, 19 d, 1 sp, 10 d, 1 sp, 13 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 10 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 13 d, 1 sp, 10 d, 1 sp, 19 d, 2 sp, 7 d, 1 sp, ch 5; turn.

24th row. 1 sp, 10 d, 2 sp, 16 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 2 sp, 16 d, 2 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 2 sp, 16 d, 2 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 16 d, 2 sp, 10 d, ch 5; turn.

25th row. 1 sp, 13 d, 6 sp, 4 d, 1 sp, 25 d, 1 sp, 16 d, 1 sp, 25 d, 1 sp, 4 d, 6 sp, 13 d, 1 sp, ch 5; turn.

One-half of pattern is now completed; to finish 2d half work 24th row, 23d, 22d, etc., until the pattern is finished.
